



RULES & REGULATIONS

- Keep your plot and the adjoining pathways tended. If your plot appears to be untended for a period of 14 days and you have not contacted the Town, your plot will be given to another gardener.
- Plant tall plants and vines in places where they will not interfere with your neighbors plot.
- At the end of the garden season, all dead plants and non-plant materials (strings, wire, metal, plastic, etc.) must be removed and disposed of properly and all gardens left neat and tidy. Plots must be cleaned to the bare ground. If the garden plot is not cleaned by 11/1/25, you will lose your gardening privileges for the following season.
- Pick up litter when you see it.
- Please remove all weeds and dead plants. Doing this will keep all invasives from neighboring plots.
- Smoking and chewing tobacco is not allowed. Tobacco can transmit a lethal virus to tomatoes and cigarette butts are loaded with toxins.
- Pets, drugs (including alcohol) and fires are prohibited.
- Please supervise children in the garden.
- For your safety, only garden during daylight hours.
- Report theft, vandalism and unusual activities.
- Must bring your own water (only water containers are allowed to be kept in the plot).
- Gardeners must keep all crops 12 inches from the edges of their plots.
- Walkways must be kept clear for safety of fellow gardeners.
- All gardens must be kept neat (i.e.: no tape, fencing, or trellis).
- We encourage being a good neighbor, pesticides are helpful but may destroy "good insects".
- Perennial crops such as but not limited to (strawberries/raspberries) are prohibited.


