

CRITERIA for INCLUSION

Population (2020 census)

20 most populous communities (Salem is #7) AND remaining cities r

OR Geographic Size

20-30 sq mi (Salem is 24.7 Sq Mi) AND Population <10,000

OR Density (Population/SQ Mi)

Density <900 AND Population <10,000

OR Town meeting (with town manager) AND Population <10,000

(There are 11 more with population >10,000

OR the two towns with Town meeting with ballot initiatives
