### **Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) Stations Project Southern NH Regional Water Project - Contract S2**

**December 10, 2019**

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As part of the Southern New Hampshire Regional Water (SNHRW) Project, the Town of Salem is expanding public water systems along Rockingham Road (NH Route 28) in the towns of Windham and Salem (see interactive project map: <https://www.townofsaalemnh.org/engineering-projects/pages/nh-route-28-water-main-projects>).

In addition to the water main installation already underway along NH Route 28 as part of Contracts S1A and S1B, work for Contract S2 has begun at the Northland Road and Rail Trail sites adjacent to NH Route 28. The project is anticipated to be substantially completed in June of 2020. Travel on Rockingham Road (NH Route 28) should not be impacted during construction.

The objective of the SNHRW Project is to address elevated levels of methyl tertiary butyl ether (MtBE), which have been found to exceed the existing groundwater quality standard within areas of the southern tier of New Hampshire. The project is being funded by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) through the MtBE Remediation Bureau and the Drinking Water and Groundwater Trust Fund (DWGTF).
