It's almost summertime and Frank Giordano, Deputy Director of Utilities, is on the switch to adjust lake levels at Arlington Pond.

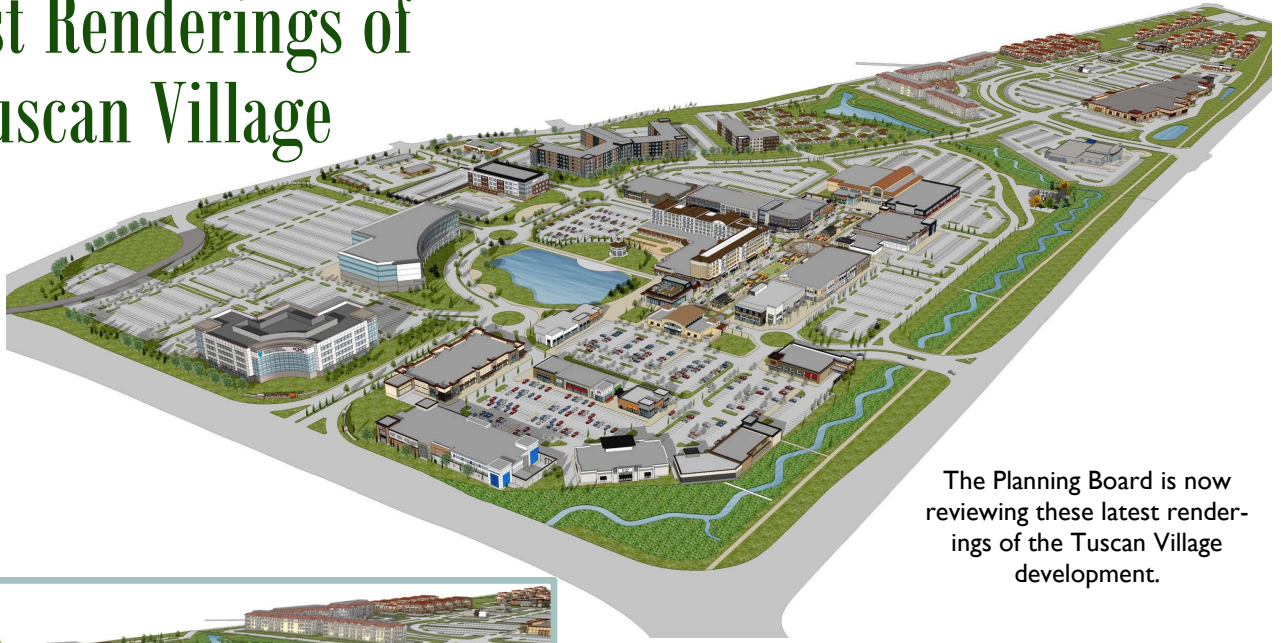
Big Island Pond flows into Arlington Pond which makes for an active Spring while the Utility Department finds the perfect balance of filling up Arlington Pond and draining off the excess. Frank tells us that Canobie Lake drinking water is at a higher grade than Arlington Pond. Canobie is a Class A and Arlington Pond is a Class B. We go on Canobie's drinking water in the Spring and return to Arlington Pond around Labor Day. We also revisit the pump station and gate house and get a good description of the function of the clear well and see the various monitoring devices. Frank also tells us about the new cameras that have been installed on the gate house, pump station and the dam.
