Pancake Breakfast Held to Assist Families Displaced by Main Street Fire




Salem TV was happy to cover the Pancake Breakfast Fundraiser for the Main Street fire victims organized by Dianne Paquette and the Salem Fire Department. Dianne and her team of "Villagers" fed people of the Salem community pancakes, sausages and fruit. A truck from ServPro was outside the Fisk School collecting donations for the Fire Victims and Isaiah 58. Assistant Chief Larry Best and Fire-fighter Troy Collins talked about the challenges of the Main Street fire.



Two great highlights from the breakfast was a touching slide show and then a presentation to Chief Paul Parisi who was honored with a "Fire Marshal" apron. The pancake breakfast raised \$5440.

We have learned that if you do a Bing search for www.TownofSalemNH.org the fourth link will redirect you to Doxo.com which is NOT the Town's online bill payment provider. This company has no affiliation with the Town of Salem, NH. We urge all water and sewer customers to pay online via the Town's website. The authorized Town website/Invoice Cloud lists all outstanding invoice amounts. 

2. To be eligible for the process a non-refundable fee of \$35.00 payable to the Town of Salem in the form of a Money Order or Cashier's check only

Once all paperwork has been turned in, your name will be added to the list for the hiring process.



Ross Moldoff - Planning Director

Planning Director Ross Moldoff met with Susan McLoughlin at Tuscan Village to discuss the project. He talks about the special features of the project, the timeline and what we can expect to see in the Tuscan Village. He also gave us a brief background on the Planning Board's efforts that started in 2008 with a Zoning Amendment ballot article that helped regulate, control, and streamline a major project like the Tuscan Village. We wrap up the show with a brief synopsis of other projects in town that confirm the general feeling that things are booming in Salem.
