

Southern New Hampshire Regional Water Project – Route 28 Water Main
Bi-Weekly Progress Report
February 4, 2020

This report identifies work on the Route 28 Water Main Project that Revoli Construction has completed in the last two weeks and anticipates progressing during the next two weeks. Roads will remain open during the day, unless otherwise noted, and delays should be expected. There may be some night time work with alternating traffic around the work zone. Officers or flaggers will help you pass through the work zones. Thank you for your patience during the construction.

Last Two Weeks

- Drilling and blasting operations in Windham continued along the project route.
- Water main installation continued moving south along Route 28 from the Derry/Windham line. Water main has also been installed adjacent to the Rail Trail parking lot and will continue south on Route 28.
