**Addendum No. 2
January 25, 2019**

The following questions have been posed to GIS Manager John Vogl by email since the release of this RFP. Answers are provided in **bold** font. This information is supplemental to Addendum #1.

Question 1. I am correct in assuming that the Pilot Area will be 2 20" x 30" tiles/sheets?

A: The RFP states the Pilot area will be 2-4 tiles in size

Question 2. How long does the Town anticipate the Pilot Area review to take?

A: We would expect that a reasonable delivery date for the pilot area would be mid-June, following a mid-April flight. We can turn around comments within 2 weeks.

Question 3. Does the Town have a preferred tile/sheet size for the digital orthoimagery?

A: Typically tiles for abutting communities have been sized roughly 3,000' by 2,000' and this also seems appropriate for Salem as well. That said, we are open to other ideas or contractor recommendations.
