

Providence Hill Road over Providence Hill Brook Construction Report

August 19th, 2013

Work Completed from August 5th through August 16th:

- Busby Construction completed all footing concrete placement and backfilled around the footings.
- The stone fill in the new streambed was placed prior to placement of the precast concrete pieces.
- All precast pieces were placed, grouted, and waterproofed.
- Backfilling operations and roadway preparation was continuing.

Waterproofing in place on the precast sections and backfilling operations taking place around the structure.

Work Scheduled for August 19th through August 23rd:

- Bridge rail concrete will be placed and metal guardrail will be attached to the bridge rail.
- All backfill will be completed and the roadway will be graded and paved with a first layer of pavement.
- All remaining storm drainage work will be completed.
- Contractor projects that the roadway will be ready to be re-opened to traffic by the end of the day on Friday, August 23rd.
