Rail Trail Phase VI Funding Request

WHEREAS: The Town of Salem submitted an application in September of 2018 to the State of New Hampshire – Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality Grant Program (CMAQ), for design, engineering, and construction of Phase VI of the Rail Trail.

WHEREAS: Funding in the amount of \$170,000.00 for design, engineering, permitting, and construction was approved by the Board of Selectmen at the August 13, 2018, meeting, notwithstanding additional monies in the amount of \$2,102.43 at their January 11, 2021, meeting.

WHEREAS: The Town of Salem entered into an agreement with NHDOT, Project SALEM, X-A004 (738), #41750, Phase VI of the Salem Bike-Ped Corridor.

WHEREAS: In September of 2024 bids were received for the project which created a funding shortfall overall that requires additional funding to proceed, following the CMAQ 80% Grant and 20% Local match model.

WHEREAS: The Recreation Advisory Committee voted unanimously at their September 12, 2024, meeting to transfer \$100,000.00 in available impact fees for the purpose of funding the additional monies needed as part of the local match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALEM TOWN COUNCIL THAT:
Funding in the amount of \$100,000.00 of Recreation Impact Fees shall be transferred to fund the required local match as outlined in the CMAQ Agreement to construct Phase VI of the Salem Bike-Ped Corridor and/or Rail Trail




