Hello,

Pursuant to **RSA 91-A (Right-to-Know Law)**, I respectfully request records or aggregate reports showing **calls for service handled by the Salem Fire Department** for the calendar years **2023 and 2024**.

Please provide **counts broken down far enough to distinguish emergency vs. non-emergency activity**, ideally aligned with **NFIRS categories**:

1. **Fire incidents** – structure, vehicle, brush/forestry (and whether “permit-only” notifications are tracked separately).
2. **EMS incidents** – distinguish between **911 emergencies** and **non-emergency/assist/IFTs**.
3. **Hazardous conditions (no fire), Service calls, Good intent, False alarms, Severe weather/other**.
4. A brief note on which categories your department includes in its official “calls for service” totals.

Preferred format: **Excel/CSV**, but PDF summaries are acceptable. If existing **annual statistical reports** cover this, those will meet my request.

If estimated costs exceed **\$50**, please advise before proceeding.
