Business owners, the public, and interested parties are invited to attend a **Public Informational Session** to be held on **Tuesday, January 20, 2026 at 5:30 PM** at Salem Town Hall, Knightly Meeting Room, 33 Geremonty Drive, Salem, NH.

The intent of the meeting is to summarize NH's Economic Revitalization Zones (ERZ) program. This program is an incentive to stimulate economic redevelopment, expand the commercial and industrial base, create new jobs, reduce sprawl and increase tax revenues by encouraging economic revitalization. Businesses located within a zone could qualify for business tax credits for projects that improve infrastructure (capital investment) and create new incremental jobs. If you are located in one of these zones and if you are planning any investment in your business and can hire one or more new full time employee(s), you could qualify to receive credits that would offset your Business Profits Tax and Business Enterprise Tax.
